LOCAL LAW NO. 2 OF THE YEAR 2017

AMENDING CHAPTER 169 OF THE POQUOTT VILLAGE CODE
VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC

BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE
INCORPORATED VILLAGE OF POQUOTT AS FOLLOWS:

1.1 Title.

This Local Law shall be entitled “Local Law of 2017 Amending Chapter 169
Vehicles and Traffic of the Poquott Village Code.

1.2. Enactment.

Pursuant to Section 10 of the Home Rule Law and the Village Law of the
State of New York, the Incorporated Village of Poquott, County of Suffolk and State
of New York, hereby enacts by this Local Law of 2017, a Local Law of the Village of
Poquott.

1.3. Effective Date.

This Local Law shall take effect on the filing of the approved Local Law with

the Secretary of State of New York, which shall be within twenty (20) days after its approval by the Board of Trustees of the Incorporated Village of Poquott.

1.4 Purpose and Intent of Local Law.

The purpose and intent of this Local Law is to amend Chapter 169 Vehicles and Traffic to provide for the safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Poquott and their guests.

2.0 General Provisions.

2.1 § 169-2 Speed Limit, of the Poquott Village Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

“§ 169-2. Speed Limit.

The maximum speed limit at which vehicles may proceed on or along any street or highway within the Village of Poquott is hereby established to be 30 miles per hour. “

2.2 § 169-4 Stop Intersections of the Poquott Village Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

“§ 169-4 Stop Intersections.

The following are stop intersections in the Village of Poquott, and all vehicles approaching the intersection in the stop posted direction shall come of a full stop at or before the stop sign:

2.3 § 169-7 Penalties for Offenses shall be amended to read as follows:

“§ 169-7 Penalties for Offenses (§ 169-1 through § 169-6)

A. The penalty for a violation of any provision of § 169-1 through § 169-6 shall be \$ 150 for the first offense, \$225 for the second offense, \$300 for the third offense and for every additional offense an additional \$50 over the prior penalty assessed under this article the fines shall be increased as stated above for penalties that occur within two years of each other.

B. All fines on all penalties authorized under Article I of Chapter 169 shall also increase as follows:

1. Failure to answer appearance ticket after 30 days from the date of the offense, the fine is doubled from the original fine amount.

2. Failure to answer appearance ticket after 60 days from the date of the offense, the fine is tripled from the original fine amount.

3. Failure to answer appearance ticket after 90 days from the date of the offense, \$100 is added to the maximum fine.”

2.4 § 169-8 Restrictions on stopping and standing shall be amended to read as follows:

“§ 169-8 Restrictions on parking, stopping and standing.

Except in an emergency or when advised to do so by a police officer as hereinafter provided, no vehicle shall be stopped or left standing on any public road or highway within the corporate limits of the Village of Poquott, except for the purpose of taking on or discharging passengers or freight and then only for such length of time as necessary for such purpose.”

2.5 The current § 169-9 Parking of Pleasure Vehicles; permit required. shall be amended to read as follows:

“§ 169-9 Permit Parking

The standing or parking of vehicles is hereby prohibited in village parks or village owned parking lots unless such vehicle displays a valid and current Village of Poquott resident parking permit on said vehicle in a manner and location specified by the Village Board. Any resident permit displayed upon a vehicle not originally assigned to that vehicle shall constitute a violation of this chapter. Special temporary parking permits may be issued by the Village only when space permits and only in advance upon written request.”

2.5 The current § 169-12 Penalties for Offenses shall be renumbered as § 169-13 Penalties for Offenses, and shall be amended to read as follows:

“Section 169-13 Penalties for Offenses (§ 169-8 through § 169-12)

A. The penalty for a violation of any provision of § 169-8 through § 169-13 shall be \$100 for the first offense, \$150 for the second offense, \$200 for the

third offense and for every additional offense an additional \$50 over the prior penalty assessed under this article the fines shall be increased as stated above for penalties that occur within two years of each other.

B. All fines on all penalties authorized under Article I of Chapter 169 shall also increase as follows:

1. Failure to answer appearance ticket after 30 days from the date of the offense, the fine is doubled from the original fine amount.

2. Failure to answer appearance ticket after 60 days from the date of the offense, the fine is tripled from the original fine amount.

3. Failure to answer appearance ticket after 90 days from the date of the offense, \$100 is added to the maximum fine.”

2.6 There shall be a new Section 169-12 of the Poquott Village Code created to read as follows:

“§ 169-12

A. No person shall double-park a vehicle on any Village highway or roadway.

B. No person shall park a vehicle in whole or part on a sidewalk located adjacent to a highway.

C. No vehicle shall be parked upon any public highway or roadway or within any Village Park without first being registered and inspected pursuant to the Vehicle and Traffic Law of the State of New York.

D. On a one-way roadway, vehicles shall be parked facing in the direction of authorized traffic movement; on a two-way roadway, such motor vehicle shall be facing

in the direction of authorized traffic movement on that portion of the roadway on which the vehicle rests.

E. No person shall park a vehicle so as to obstruct any driveway except with express permission of the owner.

F. In an established or designated parking area, a vehicle is to be wholly within the markings or signage where established or designated lines and markings are indicated.

G. The parking of trailers at any Village park is hereby prohibited at all times in all Village parks with the exception of official law enforcement or fire department use.

H. The parking of a vehicle is hereby prohibited in any area designated as "Parking for Handicap" unless the vehicle carries a special duly authorized and issued handicap parking permit. The parking permit shall be designated and distributed by the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles pursuant to § 1203-a of the New York State Vehicle and Traffic Law or by the Village.

I. When official signs have been posted prohibiting, restricting, or limiting the stopping, standing or parking of vehicles in any parking facilities, no person shall stop, stand or park any vehicle in violation of the restriction stated on such sign."

3.0 Severability

3.1. In the event that any provision of this Local Law should be deemed or determined to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, then the remaining sections of this Chapter shall continue in full force and effect."
